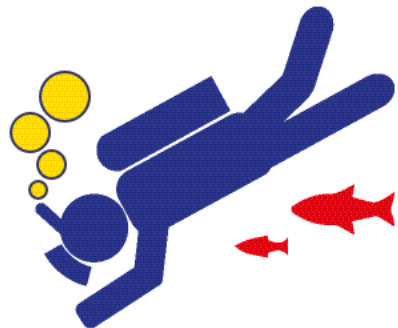

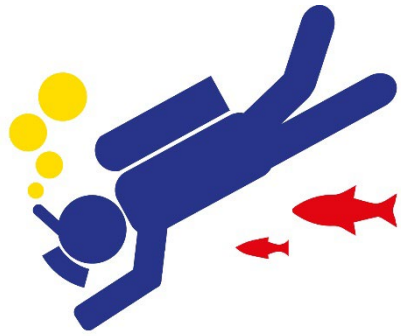

I know some of our members have decided they are hanging up their fins 'post covid' and I wish them well for the future. However you know where we are if your change your mind 😊

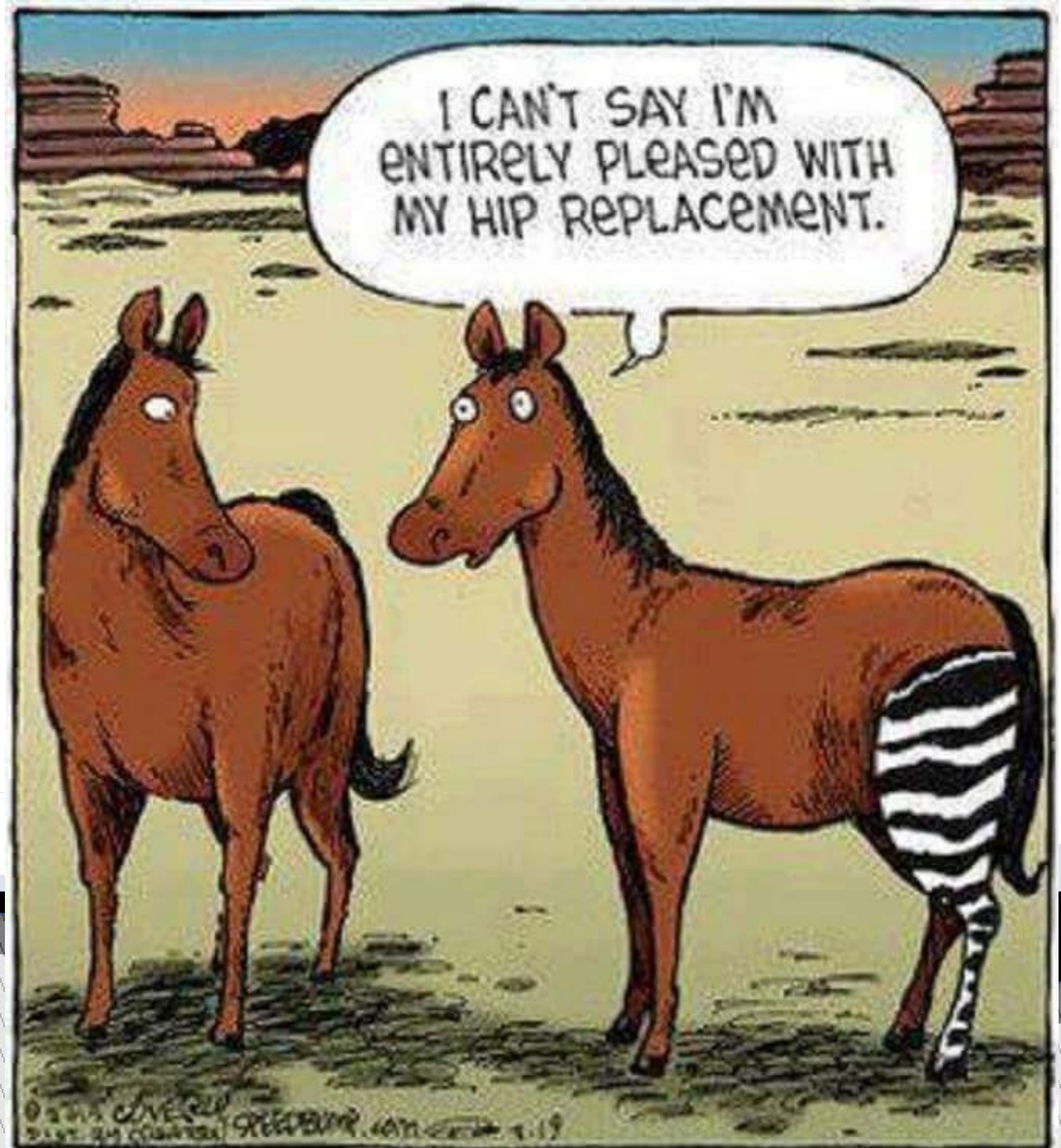
Stuck on dry land

As most of you know I had a hip replacement in August 2021 and have been forced to stay on dryland.

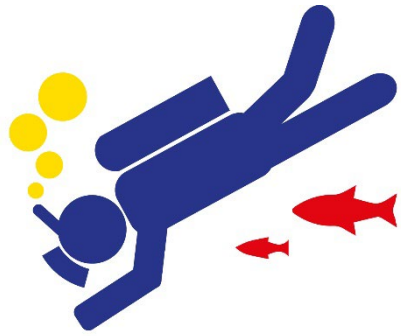
I am working hard to get back in the water during 2022

Diving is a physically taxing activity and it's important, as we get older, to try and maintain our condition to ensure our safety and enjoyment, and that of our buddies.




- I wish you all a happy and safe diving season.

Ready for the New Season?

As it's the start of the season please make sure you give all your kit an inspection to make sure it's in good condition and ready to go.


This isn't an exhaustive list, but these are some tips:

- ▶ BCD—check this inflates and holds air. All deflates work as they should.
- ▶ Regs—Put these on a cylinder and check for leaks and that they breathe ok. Check hoses and mouthpieces for wear.
- ▶ Dive computer—Check battery state and change if required.
- ▶ Torches—Check these work ok and that the battery charges/holds charge if rechargeable.
- ▶ Dry suit—Check all seals for wear and that the inflator/deflate work as they should and that the zip is working ok.


Ready for the New Season?

- ▶ Cylinders–Check they are in test and get them tested if not.
- ▶ Weights–Check belts and pockets for wear.
- ▶ Spares–Have a check through your spares kit and replace anything you used last year.
- ▶ Everything else give a check for wear especially if they've been in a cold garage or shed over the winter.
- ▶ If you do have anything that needs servicing, then get it done early as the later on in the season the timescale to get this done will be much longer.
- ▶ Last but not least make sure that **you** are fit and ready for the season

Complacency

- ▶ Don't make the mistake of thinking that your **equipment** will perform as it did when left in the garage in the autumn
 - ▶ Don't make the mistake in believing **you** will be able to carry out the same dives you did at the end of last season on your first trips out this season
 - ▶ Don't let complacency in your and your equipment's capability and fitness to dive put you in danger
 - ▶ Build up to sea diving by diving in controlled conditions first

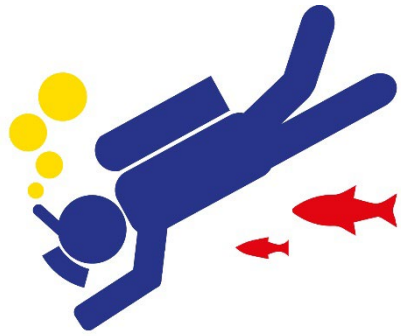
Skills Refresh and Improvement

 - ▶ Skills Improvement For Advanced Open Water Divers – Make Yourself a Better and Safer Diver by Completing the Rescue Diver and EFR Courses with ROHO




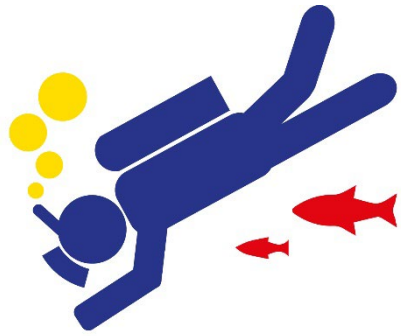

- 

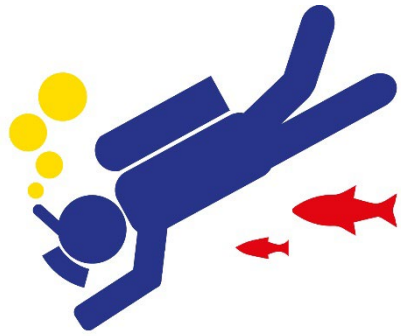
